He is a world leading surgical specialist in the treatment of bone and soft tissue sarcomas.

He is an international leader serving as a Board Member of Make-It-Better, many other academic societies, and President of the International Society of Limb Salvage, Musculoskeletal Tumor Society, and Association of Bone and Joint Surgeons.

Dr. Healey has published over 370 peer-reviewed articles, 50 chapters, and one text, and his osteosarcoma work has the most scientific citations. Dr. Healey conducts basic science research regarding osteosarcoma, funded by grants from the NIH, OREF and the American Cancer Society. He has been an editor for many leading scientific journals.
